Ithaca TSA Clubs Raise Over \$5,200 in Crowdfunding Campaign





With assistance from IthacaSTEM Advocates, the Ithaca High School and DeWitt Middle School, Technology Student Association (TSA) clubs employed a crowdfunding campaign that exceeded its goal in raising over \$5,200 to enable all members to compete at the national TSA conference in Washington, D.C., regardless of financial situation. The club members created a promotional video and spread the word about the campaign to family, friends and their extended social networks, attracting tax-deductible donations from local, regional and national sources. The campaign was a pilot project of IthacaSTEM Advocates, an affiliate of IPEI, that successfully showed that crowdfunding can be an effective fundraising tool for clubs and teams that need to raise money beyond what's possible with a bake sale or car wash.
