The Ithaca Public Education Initiative (IPEI) has awarded the first round of its quarterly Red and Gold Grants for the 2013-14 school year, including one awarded to Beverly J. Martin Elementary School for recess equipment thanks to an application written by a fifth grade student.

Teachers, staff, students and community members may apply for these one-time grants to assist with projects that strengthen and enrich the Ithaca City School District (ICSD) curriculum, have a positive impact on students, and actively engage students.

Twenty-four grants totaling \$10,355 were awarded for projects and programs that will serve more than 1,900 ICSD students.
